Waiver of bond is requested as follows:

Petitioner seeking appointment as Administrator is the mother of the decedent. She intends to marshal assets of the decedent for the exclusive use of the decedent's three children - her grandchildren - after payment of debts and expenses of administration. The decedent's children are the sole beneficiaries of his estate under California Probate Code Section 6402(a). Public scrutiny of these proceedings makes it virtually impossible for the proposed Administrator to do anything inappropriate with estate assets or in any manner harm the estate's beneficiaries or creditors. Given the nature and extent of the decedent's assets, it would be difficult if not impossible to quantify their value at this time, so the calculation of bond would be speculative at best. For these reasons, waiver of bond is respectfully requested.
