SUBJECT: TELEPHONE SECURITY CHECK FOR  
CONGRESSMAN GERALD R. FORD (MICHIGAN)

Pursuant to approval by the Director, on 11/9/65 Electronics Section personnel completed a security check of the residence telephone lines of Congressman Gerald R. Ford. This check included an inspection of the phone service within the residence, within telephone company premises and at all points of access to the telephone line outside the above-mentioned locations. No evidence of tampering was observed.

It is of interest that the telephone company Foreman Supervisor at the Alexandria Central Office (out of which Mr. Ford's telephone works) volunteered the following: The company is presently engaged in a program to expand facilities to meet the heavy increase in demand for service caused by the construction of high-rise apartments in the Alexandria area. The cable carrying Mr. Ford's telephone line has been involved. Work is also being done at the central office to install equipment for touch tone dialing. It is quite possible that there may have been some inadvertent noise on Mr. Ford's line. Also, at times of peak load for telephone use (11:00 am to 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm) there may have been a delay in getting the dial tone for making outgoing calls (increased facilities will eliminate this delay).

### ACTION:

That Inspector D. E. Moore advise Congressman Ford of the results of the security check. It is noted that Inspector Moore is a neighbor of the Congressman and the Congressman did express his concern about this problem to Inspector Moore.
